Problem

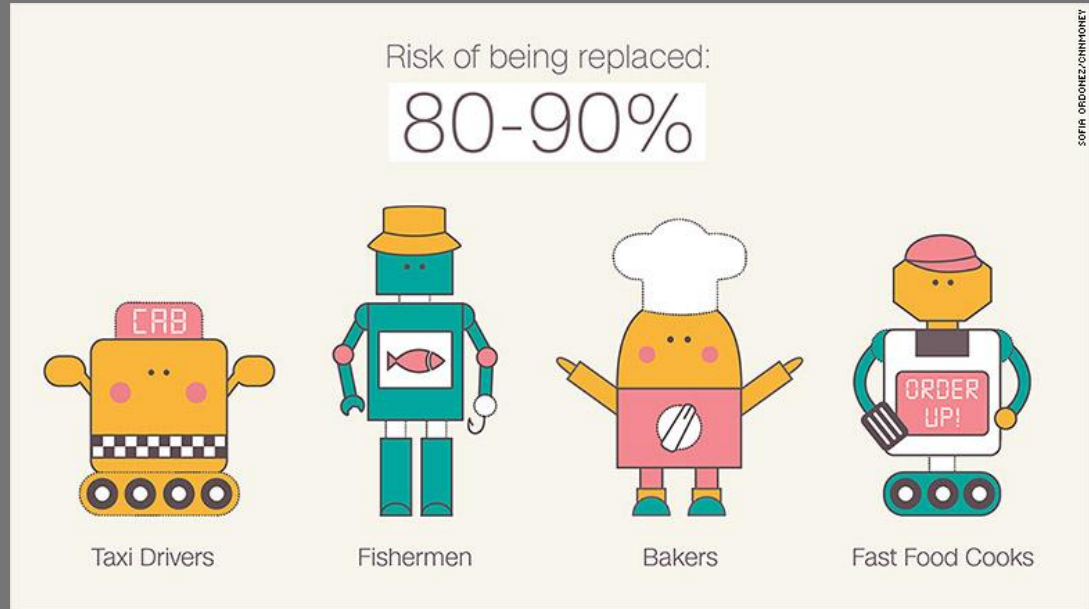
Why is this a global issue? In most countries automation will steal jobs people already are employed by humans .

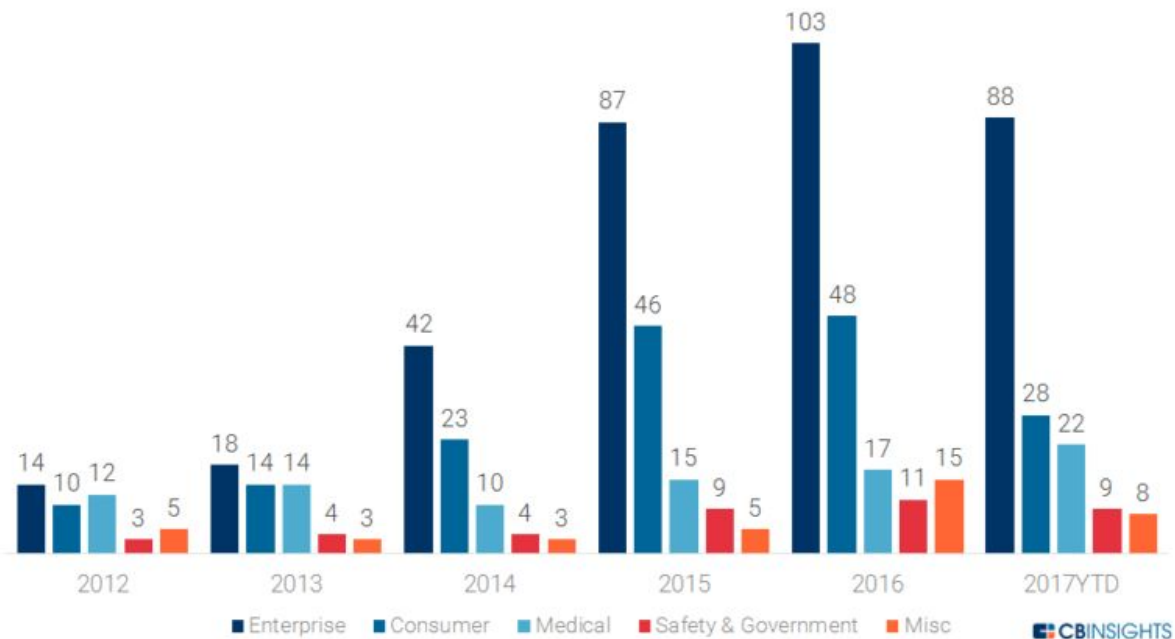

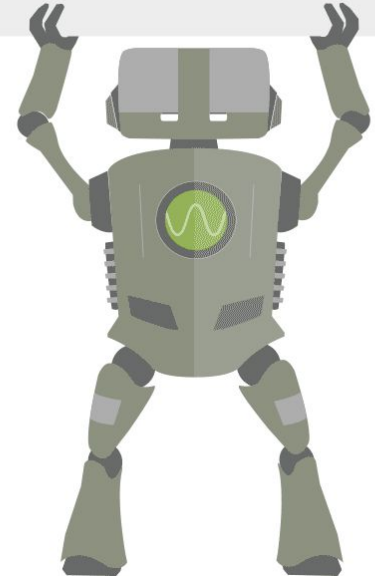

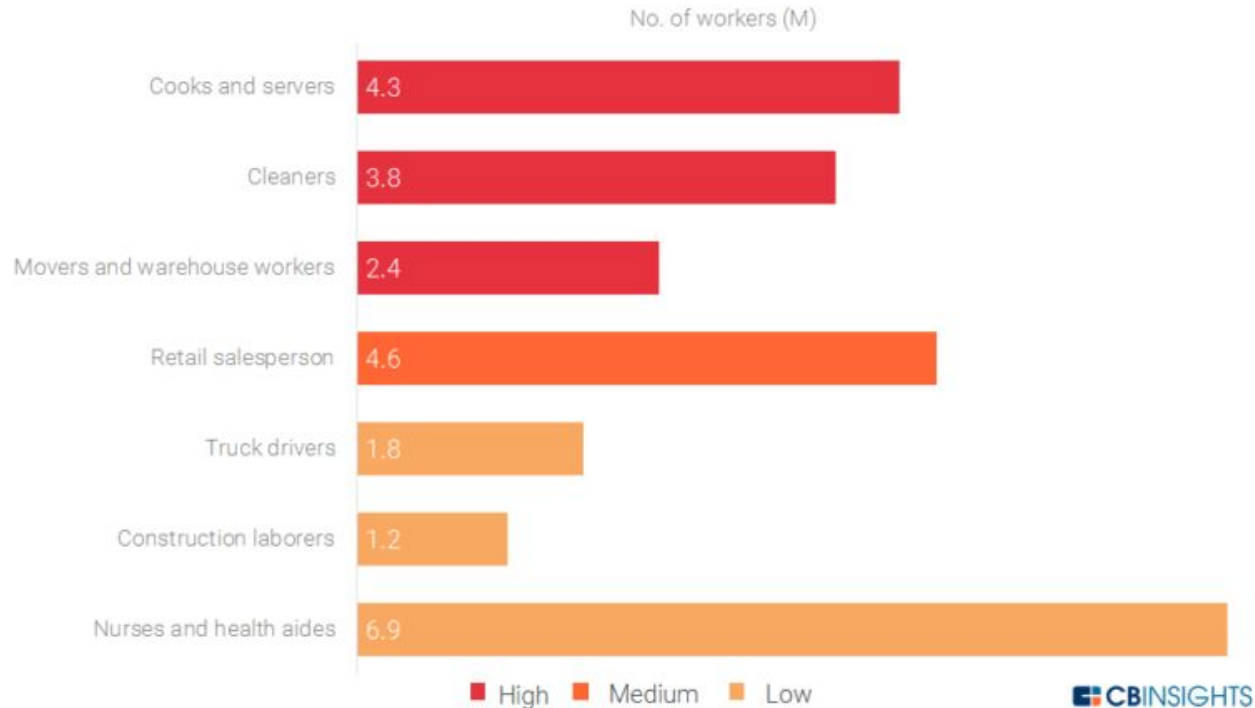
